The Oregon Coastal Management Program (OCMP) is developing an Estuary Resilience Action Plan for Lane County. The public is invited to participate in listening sessions to guide the development of a **coastal hazards vulnerability assessment** and help the state determine which coastal hazards are most concerning to the community and which assets, resources, and populations are most vulnerable. The goal of the project is to help local organizations and communities understand their vulnerabilities to various coastal hazards and identify strategies to coordinate locally led responses to increase resilience.
